# **ABFAS Anounces 2019 Board of Directors Election Results**

The American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery (ABFAS) is proud to announce the results of the 2019 Board of Directors election. Three director positions were open for the 2019 elections.

Joining the board for her first term is Dr. Michelle Butterworth from South Carolina. Two returning incumbents, Dr. William R. Adams (Kentucky) and Dr. Amberly Paradoa (Florida) will rejoin the board.

All three surgeons have held positions on numerous ABFAS committees. Dr. Adams currently holds the title of Secretary/Treasurer of the board and sits on the CBPS Foot Committee. Dr. Butterworth is a member of the Exam Blueprint Task Force and Cognitive Examinations Committee, and Dr. Paradoa sits on the Cognitive Examinations Committee, the CBPS Review Committee and the Standard Setting Committee.

All three of these terms become effective September 1, 2019 and end on August 31, 2022.
