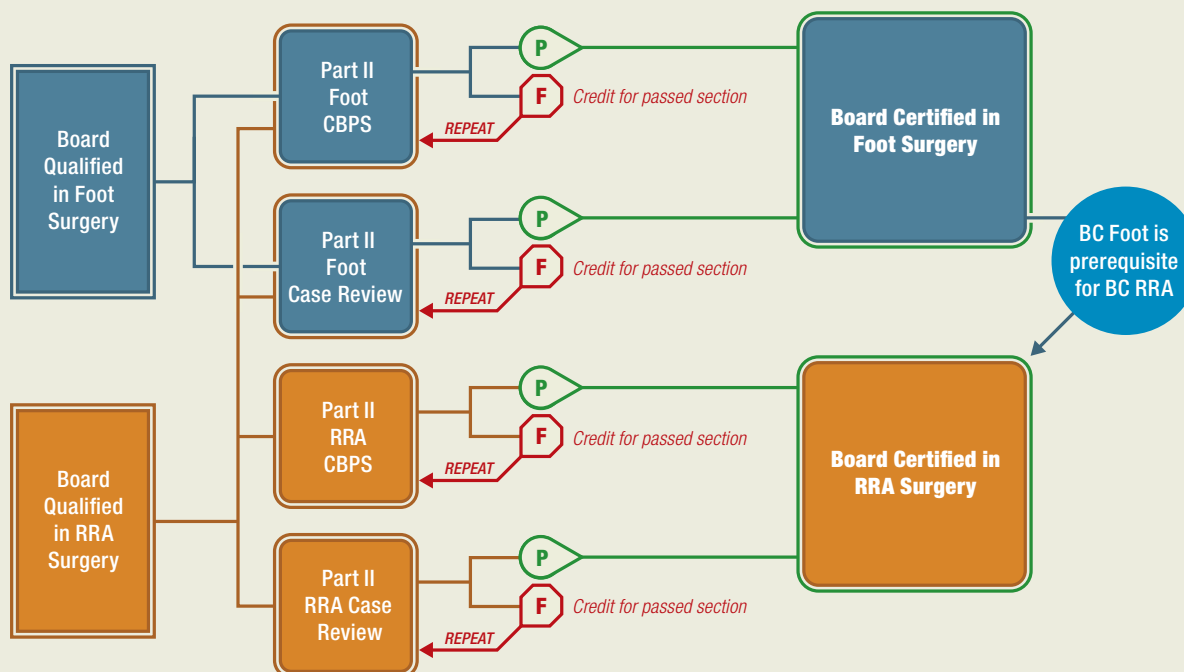


PART II CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS

Attaining ABFAS Board Certified Status

Effective until August, 2020



NOTES

All candidates must log all procedures in Podiatry Logging Service (PLS) after completion of residency.

The ABFAS Board Certification document, available on the ABFAS website, provides details for preparing for CBPS and Case Review.

CANDIDATES WHO COMPLETED LESS THAN THREE-YEAR RESIDENCY PROGRAMS BEFORE JUNE 30, 2014, AND ARE CURRENTLY BOARD QUALIFIED:

PSR-12 (plus any other residency), PM&S-24/PSR-24: May pursue board certification until December 31, 2020.

PM&S-36/PMSR/PMSR-RRR: Candidates who completed these residency programs before **June 30, 2014**, may qualify once for an additional seven years; qualification limited to a total of 14 years. May pursue certification until expiration of board qualified status.

CANDIDATES WHO COMPLETED RESIDENCY ON OR AFTER JUNE 30, 2014: Candidates have seven years from becoming Board Qualified to achieve board certification. Qualification is limited to a total of seven years.
